 Saint Luke's containing One hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to
 wit beginning at a post oak in Henry Kendrick's line thence near an East Corner to a post oak
 in Nathaniel Richelle's line thence along said Richelle's line to a pine a Corner in said Richelle's
 line thence near an East Corner of marked trees to the same mile ^{beginning} thence to a gum a Corner in said Kendrick's line thence near a West Corner to a red oak in said Kendrick's
