

Williams says This Indenture made the 7th day of December 1832 by and between George Williams
 To Jane his wife and Rachel Williams all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 Kindred one part and Henry Kindred of the County and State aforesaid of the other part Whereas the
 the said George Williams Jane his wife and Rachel Williams for and in Consideration of the
 sum of Three hundred Dollars to them in hand paid by the said Henry Kindred at or before
 the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 Have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto
 the said Henry Kindred his heirs and assigns forever One certain tract or parcel of
 land lying and being in the County and State aforesaid containing One hundred
 acres be the same more or less bounded on the north by the land of Jacob Barnes and
 Andrew Miles on the East by the land of Thomas A. W. Stone and Rhodabarr the on the
 South by the land of said Henry Kindred on the West by the land of said George Williams
 together with all and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or any ways appurtenant
 To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and premises to him the said
 Henry Kindred and his heirs forever and the said George Williams Jane his wife
 and Rachel Williams do for themselves their heirs executors and assigns forever
 warrant defend the lawful claims or claims of the said tract or parcel of land against
 themselves against all and every person or persons whatsover in all things touching the
 said George Williams Jane his wife and Rachel Williams have hereunto set their hands
 and affix their Seals the day and date above written

This Indenture was proved by the oaths of James D. Bryant one of the Justices
 of the Peace and having been proved in the Clerk's Office the 17th day of December 1832
 by the Oath of Alexander Wyrick and Jacob Barnes the other Justices of the Peace
 together with the Certificate of the Clerk of the Court of the County and the
 Court of James Williams wife of George Williams party thereto admitted
 and entered at a Court held for the County aforesaid the 20th day of May 1833
 The said Indenture and Certificate were entered upon the records of the County
