 administrators all that tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton  
 Containing twelve acres be the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Henry Realeston  
 Stephen and Geng Gentry also all the following personal property land 6 acres 120  
 and furniture 2 Sons and 11 Djs 5 head Cattle and One Short Gun with all and singular  
 the appurtenances to the said tract of land together or in any way or appertaining  
 thereto which were right title and interest of the said Simon Eckerstone and wife and  
 to the said tract or parcel of land hereby conveyed together with the said personal property  
 To have and to hold the said tract of land hereby granted by the said Simon Eckerstone  
 and wife for the sum of Thirteen Pounds and 6 pence with yearly Rent
