This Indenture made this 25 day of June in the year of our Lord 1832 between Peter Eum the debtor of the first part and John Eum Trustee of the Second part and Rebecca Creditor of the third part whereas the said Robert Eum especially inscribed to Peter Eum the sum of twenty five dollars and fifty one cents due by two notes the 1st January the 31st of March 1833 amount fifteen dollars the 2nd given the 26th day of March 1831 which debt the said Robert Eum is willing and desirous to become solvent & he has Robert Eum doth grant bargains and sell unto the said John Eum Trustee all property except land consisting of household and kitchen furniture plantation entirely together with Stock of hogs he the said Robert Eum hath granted bargained and sold unto the said John Eum his heirs or assigns all of the above property lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas he the said John Eum is to admit the said Robert Eum to remain in quiet possession of the above property to make use of his own until the said sum be paid unto Robert Eum arising of the above sum of Twenty five dollars 55 and lawful interest is not paid by the first day of January 1842 by the said John Eum is at liberty to advertise and sell at public auction for Cash all or any part of the above property sufficient to satisfy the debt with Cost and if paid in or before that time the said Robert Eum is to obtain a receipt and be able to be and of no effect Given under my hand the day and date above written.
