From To Cum
This Indenture made this 25 day of June in the year of our Lord 1832 between Robert Cum the debtor of the first part and John Cum Trustee of the second part and Rebecca Cum Creditor of the third part. Whereas the said Robert Cum is jointly indebted to Rebecca Cum the sum of twenty four dollars and fifty one Cents due by two notes the 1st bearing date the 31st of March 1813 amount fifteen dollars the 2nd given the 26th day of March 1831 which debt the said Robert Cum is willing and desirous to secure to himself and the said Robert Cum doth grant bargain and sell unto the said John Cum Trustee all of his property except lands, consisting of household and kitchen furniture Plantations utensils, tools, stock of hogs be the said Robert Cum hath granted bargain and sold unto the said John Cum his business or affairs all of the above property lying in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas he the said John Cum is to admit the said Robert Cum to remain in quiet possession of the above property to make use of the same and make the same sum be paid unto Rebecca Cum and if the above sum of twenty four dollars and fifty one Cents is not paid by the first day of January 1842 he the said John Cum is at liberty to advertise and sell at public auction for cash all or any part of the above property sufficient to satisfy the debt with cost and if paid in or before that time the said Robert Cum is to obtain a receipt and the above to be void and of no effect.
