

This Indenture made this Eleventh day of April one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three
 To Belvoir James Ellerup and Martha his wife of the County of Sussex of the one part and Lewis Adams
 Branch of the other part Witnesse that for and in Consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars one dollar
 and twenty Cents to the survivor and part by the said Lewis Adams Branch before the Statute and delivery
 of these presents the receipt whereof I hereby acknowledge that they the said James Ellerup and Martha
 his wife have granted bargained and sold unto the said Lewis Adams Branch one certain tract or parcel of
 land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton Containing by estimation two hundred
 and forty four acres to the same more or less and bounded by the lands of Richard Blasom and
 Branch and others to bear and to hold to the said land tithes and her rents and a pension from
 to the only proper use and behoef of them the said Lewis Adams Branch his heirs and assigns forever
 the said tract or parcel of land together with all the appurtenances thereto belonging and we
 the said James Ellerup and Martha his wife for ourselves on him and as fully know
 against the claim or claim demand or demands of all and every person whatsoever to the said
 tract or parcel of land to the said Lewis Adams Branch his heirs and assigns forever will warrant
 and by these presents shall warrant and defend In Witness whereof they have hereunto
 set their hands and seals this day and year before written
