Rochelle.

Said Indenture made this 13th day of April 1833 between Edward Butts of the one part
James Rochelle of the other part both of the County of Southampton Whereas William L. Evertt
an indenture bearing date the 17th day of May 1831 and according to record in the Clerk's
Office of the County Court of Southampton did convey to the said Edward Butts a tract
of land with Slaves and other property in trust and for the purchase of the said land
expenses and otherwise the said Edward Butts in execution of the same reported on him
by the said Indenture did on the 17th day of February 1832 appear to public Slaves
cash the property conveyed to him in trust at which date James Rochelle acting as
Trustee for Mr. Rebecca L. Evertt the wife of William L. Evertt became the purchaser
of the following property being a certain tract of land lying and being in the County
Southampton containing by estimation two hundred and Eighty acres more or less
by the lands of Benjamin Turner, James Gee and Thomas Garrison also one negro
Patience and one negro woman Eleanor and sundry articles of property as per bov
num and the said James Rochelle has demanded of the said Edward Butts
conveyance conveying to him the property aforesaid to be held in trust for the benefit
of Mr. Rebecca L. Evertt & on thenceforth this Indenture witnesseth that the said
Edward Butts for and in consideration of the premises and for the further consider
ation of the sum of twelve hundred and thirty three dollars fifty four cents to him
the said James Rochelle in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
and given granted bargained and sold to the said James Rochelle in trust
for the use and benefit of the said Rebecca L. Evertt the aforesaid tract of land
containing two hundred and Eighty acres also the two negro women Patience and Eleanor
and the other property as per Inventory aumus to have and to hold the said
James Rochelle in trust aforesaid to him his heirs executors and administrators forever etc
the said Edward Butts for wants of his heirs executors and administrators hereby agrees
with the said James Rochelle that he will warrant and forever defend the title to
property hereby conveyed to the said James Rochelle his heirs executors and administrators
the claim title or demands of him the said Edward Butts and all and every person
claiming or demanding the same or any part thereof by through or under law
but against the claim of no other person or persons what ever. In Testimony whereof
the said Edward Butts hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this 13th
day of April anno Domini 1833.
