That Indenture made and entered into this 25th day of April in the year of our Lord One
thousand Eight hundred and thirty three between Richard Craig of the County of Southampton
and State of Virginia of the first part John R Bryant of the same County and State of
the second part and James D Bryant of the same County and State of the third part in
order to secure the payment of the following debt One Bond executed for forty six dollars
and ninety nine Cents bearing even date with this Indenture and in consideration
of the sum of One dollar paid by the said John R Bryant at or before the executing
and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said
Richard Craig hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain
and sell unto the said John R Bryant the following property To wit One horse three
quarters bred and furniture One Cart and wheels One Squirrel Gun Eight bee hives
Six head of Cattle 2 Sows and their increase One chest and 2 pair Saddle To have and
to hold the said property herein before mentioned to be his by granted with them and
every of their appurtenances unto the said John R Bryant his heirs Executors administrators
Tors and assigns forever upon Trust Over the life that the said John R Bryant shall
