We James Mapsoning and Jesse Parker justices of the peace in and for the County of Southampton aforesaid do hereby certify that Priscilla Darden wife of Jesse Darden parties to an Catani Deed of bargain and Sale bearing date the 22nd day of November 1832 and her said answer personally appeared before us in our Court aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband after hearing said Deed fully explained to her, abjured elop'd the same to be her act and Deed, and that she had willingly signed said and acknowledged the same and was not to retract it Given under our hands and seals this 3rd day of December 1832.

This Indenture made this 22nd day of April 1833. between Nathan Cherry of the first part John W. Thomas of the second part and Edgington Joyner of the third part Witnesseth That whereas the said Edgington Joyner hath become ~~secured~~ for the said Nathan Cherry in a note executed to James Rochelle in the Sum of fifty dollars with interest from its date which note bears date with these presents and the said Nathan Cherry being willing and desiring to secure and save harmless the said Edgington Joyner on account of his being security as aforesaid. This Indenture therefore further witnesseth that the said Nathan Cherry for and in consideration of the promises aforesaid but more especially for and in consideration of the Sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John W. Thomas hath granted bargain and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and convey unto the said John W. Thomas his heirs executors or assigns One bay mule upon this Special Mode and Consideration that is to say that said John W. Thomas his executors or assigns shall at any time at the request of the said Edgington Joyner his executors or assigns after ascertaining the time and place of sale expose the said mule to the highest bidder for cash and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay and satisfy the said Note to the said James Rochelle or pay to the said E. Joyner such sum or sums of money as he may have paid on account of being security as aforesaid and the surplus if any pay to the said Nathan Cherry his heirs executors or assigns To have and to hold the aforesaid Mule unto the said John W. Thomas his heirs and assigns and the said Nathan Cherry for him self his heirs executors and assigns well forever to maintain and defend the right and title to said mule against the claim of himself and all other persons whomsoever.
