This Indenture made and entered into this the 15 day of April for the year of our
one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Edgar H. Tarsons of Southampton
County of the One part and Henry Blair of Bedford County North Carolina of the
part. Witnesseth that whereas Samuel Blair of the aforesaid County of Southampton by his
Deed in Book bearing date the 24 day of February 1831 which had been duly recorded in
the Clerk's Office of the County of Southampton conveyed to Edgar Tarsons for the purpose
of securing all his the said Samuel Blair's Credit the tract of land wherein the
Blair resided at the time of the execution of the Deed of Trust aforesaid being the same
tract of land that was conveyed to the said James Blair by Henry Blair and Edgar
his wife containing by estimation three hundred and thirty acres be the same more
less the reference to the aforesaid Deed from Henry Blair and Edgar his wife to
Samuel Blair the bondman &c. thereof will fully appear and whereas the said Edgar
Tarsons in accordance with the requisition of the aforesaid Deed of Trust did on the
19 of November 1832 sell the aforesaid tract of land to him Henry Blair became
the purchaser thereof the highest bidder and he the said Henry Blair named
a conveyance of the same which the said Edgar Tarsons is willing to execute to
this Indenture executed Witnesseth that the said Edgar Tarsons for and in
consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and fifty one dollars by the said Henry
to the said Edgar Tarsons in hand paid or secured to be paid hath granted conveyed
and sold do by these presents grant bargain and sell convey and make over unto
said Henry Blair his heirs assigns or assigns the aforesaid tract of land containing
three hundred and thirty acres be the same more or less with all the privileges
appurtenances thereto belonging to the said Henry Blair his heirs assigns
and assigns and the said Edgar Tarsons for himself his heirs executors and administrators
doth forever quit claim what ever which he delivered to the said land by the said Deed
Trust aforesaid to the said Henry Blair and will more over warrant and defend said
title only against the claims or claims of any person or persons whomsoever and
said Henry Blair his heirs and assigns. In Witness whereof the said Edgar
hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year before written
