This Indenture made in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three between Jacob Corbitt of Richmond County and State of Kentucky of the one part and Joseph Lankford of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Jacob Corbitt and Elizabeth his wife of the first part have lawfully bargained sold and delivered to the aforesaid Joseph Lankford and his heirs forever one piece or parcel of land situate lying and being in ~~Southampton~~ ^{Richmond} County Virginia containing one hundred acres to the same more or less for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Eight dollars to me in hand paid whereof I do hereby acknowledge and certify that the said land is bounded as follows to wit running along Joseph Lankford's line thence along John's Run line thence along Patrick Row's line thence along Zachariah Lankford's line thence along Elizabeth Williams' line to the beginning corner To have and to hold with piece or parcel of land. Whereof we have hereunto set in hand and caused our seals to be affixed this 12 day of January 1833.
