 Three hundred and twenty five dollars and six pence paid by the said Matthew Dick to the said Rolling
 Dick the said aforesaid whereby acknowledged the said Rolling Dick and Lydia his wife have
 granted bargained and sold and delivered by these presents to grant bargained sell and conveyned
 the said Matthew Dick and his heirs forever One certain tract or parcel of land lying
 and being in the County aforesaid containing Sixty Seven acres be the same more or less
 and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a post oak a corner of Sodan Land thence to a pine at
 corner between Benjamin Birns and said Sodan thence down Birn's line to a stone post
 oak thence by Sodan Birns line to said Rolling Dick's corner thence to the beginning with all
 singularly the appurtenances thereto belonging to his only propositus the right and title to said
 land and appurtenances were hereby warrant and defend unto the said Matthew Dick
 against the claim of himself or any person whatsoever. In Testimony whereof we have
