This Indenture made and entered into this first day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
 Eight hundred and thirty three between James Brittle of Superior of the first part, John Harrison
 the County of Southampton of the second part and Lewis St Branch of the County of Southampton
 the third part and all of the State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said James Brittle in
 consideration of the sum of two hundred Dollars which said sum is due from the
 James Brittle to the said Lewis St Branch by Bond bearing date the first day of
 One thousand Eight hundred thirty three as well as all other moneys which may be due and
 owing from the said James Brittle to the said Lewis St Branch by means of any other
 transfer of debt or paper whatever as aforesaid and in consideration of One dollar to him in
 part by the said John Harrison the receipt whereof the said James Brittle doth hereby
 acknowledge hath granted bargained sold all and by these presents doth lawfully grant bargain
 sell convey and make over unto the said John Harrison and his heirs forever all his right
 and interest in the following property to wit a certain tract or parcel of land by and by
 of Southampton and State of Virginia containing by estimation sixty two and half acres
 as follows Beginning at Harrison's line thence along the said line to the
 line thence along said Cancell's line to Lewis St Branch's line and thence along said
 line to Harrison's line thence along the said Brittle's line to the beginning
 of said tract more belonging to the said James Brittle To have and to hold with all the
 rights and interest of the said Land and more hereunto convey is or contained in
 to him the said John Harrison upon being thereto required by the said Lewis St Branch
 shall proceed to sell at the right and interest of the said James Brittle to the above
 Land and more hereby conveyed or intended to be conveyed after a writing the same
 place in the said County of Southampton for ten days previous at some public house
 Here for cash and out of the money arising out of the said sale on the first
