Brown Master of the second part and Sonal Senior of the third part Whereas the said Matilda A Bradshaw
is partly indebted to the said James Sommers the sum of fifty dollars to be paid on the 25th December next
saying sum bearing date on the 2^d day of May 1833 which debt with the legal interest thereon
accruing the said Matilda A Bradshaw is willing and desirous to secure by this Indenture
Wherefore that for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further sum of One
dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the said Matilda Bradshaw witness party the said
Robert Brown at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents doth receipt whereof hereby
acknowledges he the said Matilda Bradshaw hath given granted bargained sold aliented
enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell
doth enfeoff release and confirm to the said Robert Brown his heirs and assigns forever and
that tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia
Containing by estimation One hundred and forty acres bounded by the lands of Miles McLean
William Gray and others being the land which was left to the said Matilda Bradshaw
with all the singular appurtenances to the said tract of land belonging or in any
wise appertaining, and all the right title and interest of the said Matilda Bradshaw
in and to the said granted tract intended to be granted tract of land and premises with
all its appurtenances unto the said Robert Brown his heirs executors administrators
forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Robert Brown his heirs execu-
tors and administrators forever and the said Matilda Bradshaw for herself her heirs execu-
tors and administrators forever and the said Matilda Bradshaw for herself her heirs execu-
tors and administrators forever and the said Matilda Bradshaw to remain in quiet and
peaceable possession of the said tract or parcel of land and premises and take the profit thereof
to her own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of fifty dollars
either in the whole or in part and then upon the further trust that they he or any two
of them shall and will so soon after the happening of such default of payment as they
or any or either of them may think proper or the said Robert Brown his heirs adm or ad-
ministrators shall require till the said tract of land with the appurtenances to the highest bidder for ready
money at public auction after having had the time and place of sale at their own discretion and
given ten days notice thereof to be set at the door of the Capthouse in this County on some
day in June to the day of sale and out of the money arising from such sale shall after
paying the charges of the sale and all other expenses attending the sale pay to the said James
Sommers his heirs adm or assigns the said sum of fifty dollars with the interest accrued and the balance
of any sum to the said Matilda Bradshaw his heirs adm or assigns of the whole of the said sum
of fifty dollars shall be fully paid off and discharged to the said James Sommers his heirs
adm or assigns or before the 25th December next the sum is payable & that in case of
payment be made of the said sum of fifty dollars be made there the bond
to be void one else remain in full force and virtue
