 between Barham Mreem of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part
 Ellen Bette of the same County and State of the other part Witnesseth that I the said Barham
 Mreem for and in consideration of the Sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Ellen Bette the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
 ledged, have granted bargained and sold and do hereby grant bargain and sell unto
 her the said Ellen Bette her and her heirs forever One certain tract or parcel of land
 situate lying and being in the aforesaid County containing by estimation thirty acres
 the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a pine near the edge of the
 road a new made corner in the land said Barham bought of Robert Nicholson where
 the land belonging to John Bette dec^d Thomas Smith East to a second tree a new marking
 in said land near the kitchen thence nearly north to a pine tree a new corner in said
 Barham's land thence nearly West to a pine tree near the edge of said Bette's land
 thence along the said Road to the beginning And I the said Barham Mreem do
 warrant and forever defend the right of the said land and premises therein
 to the said Ellen Bette and her heirs forever In all things of the said Barham
