This Indenture made this 15th day of December one thousand Eight hundred and Thirtieth
 between Barkam Wrenn of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the One Part
 Ellen Bills of the same County and State of the other part Witnessed that I the said Barkam
 Wrenn for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand
 paid or secured to be paid by the said Ellen Bills the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged,
 agreed, harts granted bargained and sold and doth hereby grant bargain and determine
 me the said Ellen Bills to have and to have for ever, One certain tract or parcel of land
 situated lying and being in the aforesaid County, Containing by estimation formerly called
 the same more or less and bounded as follows beginning at a pine tree near the edge of the
 road a run made over in the land said Wrenn bought of Robert Wickham wherein
 the land belonging to John Bills &c. then a stone East to a locust tree a few rods
 in Southland near the kitchen there nearly north is a pine tree a few rods in said
 Wrenn's land thence nearly West to a pine tree near the edge of said Bills' land
 then along the said road to the beginning And I the said Barkam Wrenn do
 warrant and forever defend the right of the said land and premises aforesaid
 to the said Ellen Bills and his heirs forever. In witness whereof the said Barkam
