And I the said Polly Gay for myself my heirs Executors and assigns do give grant the said bargain property into the said Polly Gay her heirs and assigns against all manner of person or persons and will warrant and defend before present In Witness whereof with the delivery of above bargain property have her unto 17th day of May 1833

This Indenture made this 20th day of May in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred thirty three between Lawrence Joyner of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Joyner of the same County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Lawrence Joyner in consideration of the sum of forty dollars to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Joyner the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given granted bargain sold and delivered unto the said Samuel Joyner and his heirs One tract land which Samuel Joyner gave a Deed of Gift on to Lawrence Joyner and born real as follows to wit beginning at a point in John Royal's and Lawrence Joyner's line thence N 62. M 50 poles to a red oak at 13 Black water road at 66. W 98 poles to a red oak and said Lawrence Joyner's line at 100 poles to a post oak corner to said Joyner and Jesse Bick's line along said Bick's line at 29. M 20 poles to a red oak at 11. E 24 poles to a point a corner of said Bick and John Royal's thence along said Royal's line N 73. E 20 poles to a point S 62. E 28 poles to a point S 62. E 13 poles to a point and thence S 69. E 45 poles to the beginning by estimation Thirty three and quarter Acres To have and to hold the said parcel of land together with all and singular the appurtenances to him the said Samuel Joyner and his heirs forever and the said Lawrence Joyner his heirs Executors and assigns do give grant the said parcel of land with all its appurtenances to him the said Samuel Joyner his heirs assigns title and will warrant and forever defend.
