Recd. This Indenture made the 20th of May 1833 Between John Hart and Elizabeth his wife both of the
County of Southampton and State of Virginia and in the Parish of St Lukes of the One part and
Samuel Moore of the County of King and State of North Carolina of the other part witnesseth
that the said John Hart and Elizabeth his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of One thousand
and twenty five dollars Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Samuel
Moore hath bargained sold alured entreated and Conformed and by these presents doth
grant bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Moore his heirs and assigns forever One certain
tract or parcel of Land situated lying and being in the County State and Parish aforesaid con-
taining by a late Survey three hundred and fifty acres and One half thereof as follows begin-
ning at a post standing in the State line a new corner made between John Hart and the
said Samuel Moore thence along the State line due E 25° poles to a post a corner of
Sister Marden thence at N E 22° poles thence at S W 16° poles onto Virginia line thence
due with N E 22° poles to a Hickory a new corner made between John Hart and Samuel
Moore standing near the side of the road thence along said Road S S 56° W 180 poles to a
small red oak bush a new corner made by John Hart and the said Samuel Moore
thence S S 11° W 40 poles near a small branch thence along the run of said Branch to the
first Station house S S 22° W 60 poles from the Branch to the beginning together with all
the harvest gardens orchards ways waters and all privileges whatsoever belonging
over any road appertaining to the said tract or parcel of land To have and to hold
the same unto the said Samuel Moore and his heirs forever and the said John Hart
and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and administrators by these presents
Covenant and agree to and with the said Samuel Moore his heirs and assigns forever
to warrant and defend all rights claims or demands of all persons or farms whatever
either in Law or Equity. In witness whereof the said John Hart and Elizabeth
his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date
first above written
