H. Adams of the other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said La Fayette Brown for and in Consideration of the Sum of Five hundred and fifty dollars Current money of the State of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said S. H. Adams at or before the end aforesaid and delivery of these premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold and by these presents have granted bargained and sold unto the said Adams and his heirs and assigns with him the said S. H. Adams his heirs and assigns forever one certain Lot or parcel of land Situate lying and being in the Town of Williams in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia known in the plans of the said Town by number Thirteen Containing by Estimation two acres be it the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit On the North bounded by the said Adams his heirs and assigns along by the West End of a Brick house or there on Lot A. 14. which is an acre or by S.
