of Bargain and Sale bearing date on the 1st day of June 1833 between us and the said Lafayette Brown
before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from the Plaintiff
after said deed was fully explained to her acknowledged the same to be her act and deed
and that she had willingly signed sealed and acknowledged the same and further did
retract it Given us in our hand and sealed the 24th day in the year One thousand
Eight hundred and thirty two

This Indenture made and entered into on the 26th day of May in the year of our Lord
One thousand Eight hundred and Thirty Two Between Lafayette Brown and Margaret Mahone
of the one part and J. S. Mahone of the other part all of the County of Southampton and
of Virginia Wttnsfch that the said Lafayette Brown for us in Consideration of the sum
of fifty dollars Current money of Virginia of the State of Virginia to him in hand paid
the said J. S. Mahone at or before the inscating and delivery of these presents the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell alien of scoff and Anfom unto him the said J. S. Mahone
his heirs and assigns forever One certain Lot or piece of Land Situate lying and bounded
abutting the Town of Elmo in the aforesaid County of Southampton and lot of 100 acres
being by estimation One half acre to the same more or less and bounded as follows
Beginning at a Cypress post on thence a norw Course for Lafayette Brown thence
77 1/4 E 40 poles to a lightwood post a corner thence 23 1/4 E 18 1/2 poles to an Elm tree
the Edge of a Rotten River thence down Course into said River thence up said River to
Lot lately occupied by Harry Ross to Wm. McCutchen which lot was formerly
Elm in allusion to the said Ross thence along the line of said River to a tree
Course to said Ross's Corner whis said line a westerly course to said tree
along said tree a southerly course to the first station. Together with all right the
clerk and dem and of in and to the said Lot or piece of land and to all
with its appurtenances there belonging or in any wise appertaining to have
to hold the above described Lot of Land and premises with all and singular its
appurtenances thereunto belonging unto him the said J. S. Mahone his heirs and
assigns forever to and for the only proper use and behoef of him the said J. S. Mahone
and his heirs and the said Lafayette Brown for behoef of his heirs and assigns
assigns forever to and by these presents given and agreed to and with the 100
Pounds J. S. Mahone his heirs executors administrators and assigns that he will furnish
by these presents warrant and defend the right and title of the aforesaid lot
