 Indenture

This Indenture made this 10th day of August 1832 between John G. Miller of Southampton County one of the Justices of the Peace of the County and State aforesaid of the one part and Wiley K. Jenkins of John County and State aforesaid of the other part Whereas the said John G. Miller is greatly indebted to the said Wiley K. Jenkins in the sum of Seventy five Dollars to be paid on or before the first day of September next ensuing with legal interest thereon until paid as by Bond bearing date with this Indenture which said debt the said John G. Miller is willing to secure and therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him the said John G. Miller in hand paid by the said Wiley K. Jenkins at or before the making and delivery of these premises the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said John G. Miller hath given granted bargained and sold alone and of his own free will and consent and by these deeds give grant bargain sell all in whole or in part released and confirmed unto the said Wiley K. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever all that tract or parcel of land which the said John G. Miller purchased from Allington Edwards lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and adjoining the lands of Jesse Gardner and Peter H. Johnson when containing forty three acres more or less and whereon the said John G. Miller now lives also one acre and half more or less beds and furniture household and kitchen furniture of every description together with all and singular their appurtenances to the said tract or parcel of land belonging or in any way appertaining and all the right title and interest of the said John G. Miller in and to the said personal property also his entire interest in said tract or parcel of land. To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land with the said personal property unto the said Wiley K. Jenkins his heirs and assigns forever Upon Final need the life that as soon after the default of the payment of the aforesaid debt of seventy five dollars and interest thereon as the said Wiley K. Jenkins shall think proper or shall request by notice to the said John G. Miller shall proceed to sell the said tract of land and personal property of one kind to the highest bidder for ready money at public auction or after having fixed the time and place of said sale by three advertisements one of which shall be published at the Court house door of said County one some one Court day previous to the day of sale and out of the money arising from
