This Indenture made this 13th day of March 1830, between Freely Barnes of the County of
first part John R Williams of the Second and Thomas Porter of the third part all of the County of
Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Freely Barnes is mostly indebted to the said
Thomas Porter in the sum of Thirty five dollars due by Note bearing date the day and date above written
and being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the same to the said Indenture witnesseth
that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar in hand paid by John R Williams to this
said Freely Barnes at and before the executing and delivering of these presents to the witness
whereof he hereby acknowledge hath given granted bargained sold and delivered and doth
hereby present give grant bargain sell and deliver unto John R Williams Barnes & his espouse
Catharine his wife all his household and kitchen furniture farming utensils together with his Crops
to be found upon his farm and to hold the same upon trust notwithstanding that the said
John R Williams his heirs &c shall permit the said Freely Barnes to remain in quiet possession
of the aforesaid property until default be made in the payment of the aforementioned sum
of Thirty five dollars either in part or in the whole and so soon as default be made in the aforesaid
said debt the said John R Williams his heirs &c shall at the request of him the said Thomas
Porter cause the said property to be exposed to public sale after giving legal notice and time
of the sale and of sale cause the aforesaid sum of Thirty five dollars with interest and
cost to be paid to the satisfaction of him the said Thomas Porter and the surplus money
of any payment to him the said Freely Barnes his heirs &c but if the aforesaid sum of
Thirty five dollars cost &c be paid to the satisfaction of him the said Thomas Porter over
before the 15th of October next thenthus Indenture to be void this witnessman in full
force and virtue as witness and seal the day and date above written.
