

Burying as will appear by Deed from the said Hamlet Drury to the said Ethelred Drake, duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton. To have and to hold the said tract of land and premises with its appurtenances unto him the said Gentleman & Elizabeth Drake and promises with its appurtenances unto her the said Gentlewoman & Elizabeth Drake is to be permitted to retain possession of the said lands and premises during the profits thereof to her own use until the 25<sup>th</sup> day of December next the term of which the debt aforesaid becomes due at which time or at any time thereafter of the said Ethelred Drake shall fail to pay the said Elizabeth Drake the debt aforesaid and the costs attending this Indenture it shall and may be lawful for the said Gentleman Edward being then so required by the said Elizabeth Drake to make sale of the said lands and premises aforesaid so much thereof as may be sufficient to pay the same and to declare the time place and terms of sale for at least ten days by advertisement set up at two or more public places in the neighbourhood and out of the town arising from said sale first pay and discharge all usual and necessary costs attending the sale and this conveyance, then pay and discharge the debt aforesaid or so much thereof as may be due at the time with the interest which may have accrued and the balance of any pay to the said Ethelred Drake his executors personal representatives and the said Gentleman R. Edward Cramant with the stipulation that he will well and faithfully execute the trusts reposed in him and that if the said Ethelred Drake shall satisfy the debt aforesaid hereby incurred be paid and the cost attending this Indenture that he will release to the said Elizabeth Drake the property aforesaid as is Conveyed and the said Ethelred hereby Cramant with the said Gentleman R. Edward that if a Sale of such lands should be made under the above that he the said Edward may employ the seller or buyer by alias a fee simple estate in the same.
