 and his heirs or assigns for the express purpose of paying the said sum of
 as above Specified and in case default should be made it is hereby agreed
 declared to be the true intent and meaning of this indenture that if the said
 sum interest and cost be not paid unto the said Benjamin Williams or
 assigns &c in or before the twentieth day of December next then the said
 Benjamin Williams shall be at liberty at any time thereafter when it may
 suit him the said debt or any part thereof remaining unpaid to require
 and compel the said Edwin B. Cland to take up his possession all the property
 Specified in this Deed and after advertising the same and placed of sale for
 least ten days at three public places convenient to the residence of the said James
 Myrick to sell for ready money all the property contained in this Deed or which
 as will be sufficient to answer the purpose herein Specified and the said Edwin
 B. Cland shall have full power and Authority to make over in writing a bill
 of sale and title to the purchaser or purchasers of said property unto the said James
 Myrick his heirs &c shall be forever entitled from setting up any claim to
 either in law or Equity and the money arising from such sales first to be paid
