 and thirty three between Samuel Kells and all any his wife of the first part and
 R. Elder and of the second part, and Rich R Strong Ho of the third part all of the
 County of Southampton and State of Virginia Whereas the said Samuel Kells is
 justly indebted to the said Rich R Strong Ho in the sum of five hundred
 and fifty nine dollars and nine cents, as will appear by sundry notes for the
 sum bearing date as follows, One for the sum of Three hundred and eighty nine
 dollars dated Jan'y 1. 1830. One payable to O. Richs for two hundred and
 fifty two dollars dated Jan'y 5 1830. due Oct 1. 1830. one for four hundred and thirty
 dollars 42 cents dated March 1. 1830. 1 d for 346. 58. dated May 25. 1833. d for
 \$39.05 dated June 18. 1833. And whereas the said parties of the first part in order
 to secure and have agreed to secure the payments of the said debts and interest with all charges
 attending the same or incurred by reason of the premises by conveying the property hereinafter
 mentioned unto the said party of the second part in trust to be sold for that purpose
 therefore this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Samuel Kells and all any his
 wife in consideration of the premises and of the sum of One dollar to them by the
 said Strong Ho in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
 and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell conformable and make over to
 the said William R. Elder and his heirs Executors administrators and assigns the
 following property to wit. One tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
 One hundred and sixty five acres it being the land the said Kells has just
 purchased of John Richs as will appear by deed duly now on record in the
 Office of Southampton County also 4 feather beds 2 Bureaus 8 dogwood chairs
 3 Tables 1 dog kennel and forks. 2 dog plates. 2 dog sporns together with all
 other Crockery Ware ware &c belonging to the said Kells. 3 pots 1 pan 1 iron
 and all other Kitchen furniture 1 Gun One horse 1 saddle 1 head of cattle 1
 of hogs one negro woman named Betty To have and to hold the said Estate and
 property above mentioned unto him the said William R. Elder and his heirs
 assigns and assigns In Trust and when Consideration never to develop that it shall
 be lawful for him the said Trustee or in case of his death for his legal person
