Gray This Indenture made this 19th of June 1833 between T R Gray of the first part Peter A Mughart of the second part and Rich R Strong and his of the third part witnesseth that the said Gray hath hereby granted bargained sold and Conveyed unto the said Richard A Mughart his heirs Executors and Administrators the following property to all the interest that the said Gray hath in and to the lands formerly his father in the County of Southampton also five hundred dollars in Bonds and accounts due and payable from several persons in the County of Southampton to the said Gray to have and to hold the aforesaid property to him the said P A Mughart his witnesseth to have and to hold the aforesaid property to him the said T R Gray his witnesseth upon Trust to whereby that whereas the said Rich R Strong the same is bound as security for the said Gray in a bond executed to said Edward Lawrence and payable in July next for about the sum of Five hundred Dollars and the said Gray being anxious to secure them from harm on that account took this Indenture witnesseth that if the said Gray shall make default in the payment of the said Bond when it shall become due the said P A Mughart after two calendar Days of Notice which he is intituled to shall proceed to sell and collect the property and debts hereby Conveyed within Sixty days from such default or failure of the said Gray to pay the Debt due to said Lawrence in July next and not before, and after having got the payment of the said Bond to the said Lawrence pay over the balance to the said Gray his witnesseth In witness whereof the parties have hereunto set their hands and Seals this 19th day of June 1833.
