This Agreement made and entered into this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three between Timothy S. Bacham of the County of Suffolk  
witness of the first part, John Gray of the said County of the second part and Clarinda  
wife of the said Timothy Bacham of the third part witness that for and in  
consideration of the natural love and affection which he bears to his said wife and of  
the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said John Gray before the sealing  
of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said Timothy  
Bacham has granted bargained sold and Conveyed and by these presents doth grant  
bargain sell and convey unto the said John Gray the following property to-wit a certain  
tract or parcel of land containing four hundred and ~~forty~~<sup>forty</sup> six acres lying on the three  
breaks in the County aforesaid it being so much of his dec'd father's lands as now attelle  
and brieve app't to him in the division thereof, the mates and bounds whereof will more fully appear  
by reference to the Report of the Commissioners who effected the said division by order  
of the County Court of Southampton ales negro slaves Amy, Dennis, Frank, Gels, Lumar,  
and Chang, with their future increase and one bay horse and the following articles  
of household and Kitchen furniture to-wit a table, chairs and Crockery, one bed and  
furniture, six chairs, two tables, one pot one spider one oven, and one frying pan to  
have and to hold the said parcel of land with its appurtenances the said slaves  
and other property aforesaid to him the said John Gray his executors and assigns from  
henceforth notwithstanding that he is to permit the said Timothy Bacham and wife  
to retain possession of the property aforesaid during their joint lives and moreover  
the profits thereof for the support of his said himself and any other child or  
children which they may hereafter have and on the death of the said Timothy  
Bacham to convey the said property to the said Clarinda S. Bacham for her life with  
the remainder to any child or children which she may have borne to him the said

Timothy S. Bacham, and if the said Clarinda shall die first the said Timothy  
is to hold the said property for the use and support of such child or children and if  
more than one to convey it to the said Timothy S. Bacham. And the said Timothy  
S. Bacham covenants with the said John Gray that he shall have a good title to the  
said property and professor thereof when required for the purpose of this Trust.  
And the said John Gray covenants with the said Timothy and the said Clarinda  
S. Bacham that he will and will faithfully execute the trust herein confided to him  
in witness whereof the said parties have hereunto set their hands and affixed their
