 the 15 day of March 1831 and recorded in the Clerk's Office of the said County
 Southampton, John Williford conveyed to the said Spearley Williams of the first part
 a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County aforesaid the bono lomo lomo
 are therein fully described and set forth and therein said to contain one hundred
 and twenty two and one half acres more or less for the purpose of securing the payment
 of the sum of two hundred and thirty seven dollars with the accreting interest thereon
 thereby acknowledged to be due and owing by the said Williford to Alexander S. Petre
 Esq. with power and Authority at the request of the said Alexander S. Petre
 advertising the time and place of sale at least ten days in the said County to
 sell the said tract of land to the highest bidder for the best price that could be
 obtained and whereas the said Petre has made of the said Williams the request
 aforesaid: and whereas the said Williams after duly consulting with the request
 and directions of the said Deed, hath this day exposed the said tract of land to
 sale and the said John Drury became the purchaser thereof: This Indenture
 therefore Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the premises and of the value
 of one hundred and One dollar twelve and a half Cents to him in hand paid by
 the said John Drury the said Spearley Williams hath given granted conveyed
 sold unto the said John Drury the tract of land aforesaid with the appurtenances
 To have and to hold unto the said John Drury the said tract of land to him and his
 heirs and assigns. And the said Williams for himself and his heirs and all persons
 claiming by or under him, doth warrant and defend all right title and
