Between Collin W Barnes and Louisa his wife of
the County of Southampton and State of N. Carolina of the first part and Sally Everett
of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the second part. Whereas it is
agreed between the said Collin W Barnes and Louisa his wife for and in consideration of the
sum of One Hundred Dollars to them in hand paid and also one negro girl by the name
of Sarah delivered, and also the amount of the legacy given by the Will of Robert
~~late his son Peter Sandell~~
Sandell, now to be paid by the said Sally Everett to the said Peter Sandell granted her
named sold alienated bequeathed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant her said
sum in full and confirm unto the said Sally Everett her heirs and assigns, one certain tract
of land lying in the County of Southampton, containing three hundred and seventy
five acres, to the same more or less, bounded by the lands of Richard Hunt, Jacob Barnes
and Charles Bryant being the same tract of land which was deeded by the said Sally
Everett to John Faircloth and willed by John Faircloth to the said Collin W Barnes
to have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said Sally Everett her heirs
and assigns forever, and the said Sally Everett doth hereby for herself her heirs
and assigns Covenant and agree to and with the said Collin W Barnes and Louisa his wife
to quiet and discharge the said Collin W Barnes of a legacy left by John Faircloth
dec'd to Peter Sandell, his legacy and to pay and satisfy the said Peter the full
amount of his legacy aforesaid for and on Consideration of the before mentioned con-
ditions premises and to stand responsible for the legacy aforesaid and the said
Collin W Barnes and Louisa his wife doth hereby Covenant and agree to and with
the said Sally Everett to warrant and defend the right and title in the above granted
premises unto the said Sally Everett her heirs and assigns forever, against the claim
and demands of all and every person or persons claiming under them. In witness
