Barnes & Co To Everitt. This Indenture made this 14th day of September in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight hundred and thirty two. Between Collier W^m Barnes and Louisa his wife of the County of S^c Ampton and state of N^c Carolina of the first part and Sally Everitt of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the second part. Witnesseth that the said Collier W^m Barnes and Louisa his wife for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars to them in hand paid and also one negro girl by the name of Sarah delivered, and also the amount of the Legacy given by the Will of John Faircloth Esq^r to the said Peter Faircloth now to be paid by the said Sally Everitt to the said Peter which granted bargain sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Sally Everitt her heirs and assigns, One certain tract of land lying in the County of Southampton, containing three hundred and seventy five acres, be the same more or less, bounded by the lands of Richard P^hewitt, Jacob Barnes and Charles Bryant being the same tract of land which was deeded by the said Sally Everitt to John Faircloth and Willed by John Faircloth to the said Collier W^m Barnes To have and to hold the said tract of land unto the said Sally Everitt her heirs and assigns forever and the said Sally Everitt doth hereby for herself her heirs and assigns Covenant and agree to and with the said Collier W^m Barnes and Louisa his wife to acquit and discharge the said Collier W^m Barnes of a Legacy left by John Faircloth dec^d to Peter Faircloth his Legatee and to pay and satisfy the said Peter the full amount of his Legacy aforesaid for and in consideration of the before mentioned bargain premises and to stand responsible for the Legacy aforesaid and the said Collier W^m Barnes and Louisa his wife doth hereby Covenant and agree to answer the said Sally Everitt to warrant and defend the right and title in the above granted premises unto the said Sally Everitt her heirs and assigns forever against the claim and demands of all and every person or persons claiming under them.
