This Indenture made this 8 day of July in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand Eight hundred and thirty Three between Henry B Laughan of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia on the one part and Fielding Rose of the County of Sussex and State of Maryland on the other part Witnesseth that the said Henry B Laughan for and in consideration of the Sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Fielding Rose the receipt of which he the said Henry B Laughan doth hereby acknowledge and acknowledge have bargained and sold aliened, sold, cleared and confirmed and do hereby these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Fielding Rose his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid and bounded by the lands of Henry Harris Peter Edmon & the lands belonging to the orphans of Commodore Benjamin Blount dec'd, David Waller and the lands belonging to the orphans of John F. Hughes dec'd Containing four hundred and Eighty six and three fourth acres be the same more or less with all and singular the rights, privileges, improvements and appurtenances of all and every kind whatsoever the said tract or parcel of land to him the said Fielding Rose his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and he the said Henry B Laughan for himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns doth covenant to and with the said Fielding Rose his heirs Executors administrators and assigns that the said land is free and clear of all incumbrances whatsoever and that he has good right full power and lawful Authority to grant sell and convey the same hereby warranting and defending the legal title then of not only against himself his heirs Executors administrators and assigns but against the just title of any person or persons whatsoever.
