consideration of the sum of One dollar to him and his heirs specially by the said Fielding Rose
the receipt whereof he the said Henry B. Claugham doth hereby confesses acknowledge
have bargained and sold above and off release and confess and declare by these presents
grant bargain and sell unto the said Fielding Rose his heirs Executer, administrators and
assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid and bounded by the lands of Kent
Hans Peter Colver & the lands belonging to the orphans of Commander Benjamin
Blunt dec'd, Lewis Waller and the lands belonging to the orphans of John
Fitzhugh dec'd Containing four hundred and Eighty six and three fourth acres to the
same moreover with all and singular the rights privileges improvements and appur-
tenances of all and singular the said tract or parcel of land to him the
said Fielding Rose his heirs Executer, administrators and assignees and to the said
Henry B. Claugham for himself his heirs Executer, administrators and assignees to con-
cern him to and with the said Fielding Rose his heirs Executer, administrators and assignees
that the said land is free and clear of all encumbrances whatsoever and that he has
good right full power and lawful authority to grant sell and convey the same
herself warranting and defending the legal title thereto of not only against himself
his heirs Executer, administrators and assignees but against the just title of any person
