 is hereby acknowledged, have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents
 do give grant bargain and sell unto the said ~~unto the said~~ Alldredge Bradshaw
 his heirs and assigns forever all of their undivided interest in and to a certain tract
 or parcel of land now in the possession of the Widow and heirs of William Bradshaw
 dec'd including the down interest at the death of the said Widow and bounded by
 the lands of Laurence Copner, Samuel Copner, and Black Creek and the undivided
 tract containing thirty one acres and belonging to two parties beside the down interest
 To have and to hold the aforesaid interest including the down right whensoever
 maybe released with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto
 the said Alldredge Bradshaw his heirs and assigns forever and the said Ethelbert
 Bradshaw and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and admin-
 istrators the said undivided interest in and to the said land or above described
