 bounded as follows to wit beginning at a Bridge on the North side of the Mill Swamp
 where the Road Crops, a Corner to William Francis thence along the road to
 the said Francis land as it meanders, to a pine a Corner to Benjamin Francis
 thence S.W. 1/4 Sec. 16 to a Branch down the said Branch and thence S.W. 1/4
 Mill Swamp, up the said Swamp to a ditch in which it has been turned into the
 said Ditch and Swamp to the beginning. To have and to hold the said parcel of
