This Indenture made and entered into this the 16th day of July 1833 between Richard P. Nicholas
 of the first part Deedee R. Edwards of the second part, and Charles C. Briggs Sampson C. Reese and
 Ann C. Nichols of the third part. Witnesseth that whereas the said ~~Richard P. Nicholas~~ Charles C. Briggs stands
 bound as Security for the said Richard P. Nicholas in a bond or note due William S. Clementy
 for the sum of five hundred dollars due and payable sometime in November next the said Charles
 C. Briggs and Sampson C. Reese are the securities for the said Richard P. Nicholas in a
 bond due Richard C. Briggs for one thousand dollars payable the 18th Instant also the said
 Briggs and Reese are the securities of the said Richard P. Nicholas in an Indenture bond
 payable George Blom aforesaid of Saml. P. Cannon in the penal sum of One thousand ~~and~~ and
 unity six Dollars, ninety four Cents and Orths in the Clerk's Office of the Circuit Superior
 Court of Law and Chancery for Southampton and the said Sampson C. Reese and Ann C. Nichols
 also are the securities for the said Richard P. Nicholas in the following sums of money lent
 to a note due Saml. A. Applewhite for the sum of Six Hundred dollars or thereabouts to a note
 due Joseph S. Dand for the sum of three hundred dollars or thereabouts and to a note due
 James Blunt for the sum of three hundred dollars or thereabouts and the said Richard P. Nichol-
 as being desirous of indemnifying and saving himself the said Charles C. Briggs
 Sampson C. Reese and Ann C. Nicholas against all loss of damage or in any manner which they
 may sustain in consequence of their Security he has paid as well for and in consideration
 of the premises as of the further consideration of the sum of One dollar to him by the said
 Deedee R. Edwards in hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged given
 granted bargained and sold and doeth by these presents give grant bargain and sell unto
 the said Deedee R. Edwards his heirs Executors administrators or assigns the following
 property to wit a full and the said Richard P. Nicholas's interest in the Slave called
 to him another Ann C. Nicholas as her dower in the Slave of her deceased husband John
 Nicholas de^d also his interest in the lands allotted to the said Ann Nicholas as dower in
 the lands of her said deceased husband John Nicholas de^d as well that to which he is entitled
 in his own right or that to which he doeth title to by purchase from Charles C. Briggs wife
 also one bay mare called by her as one Corral Kelly Agnes (the produce of said mare's previous
 Litter) and their future increase one Shallow Red Cow and one other Shallow Hind and the
 clear profits arising from the said Shallows the present or any future seasons also one acre or
 less and half and two riding or cart horses To have and to hold the Estate and
 property aforesaid unto him the said Deedee R. Edwards his heirs Executors and administrators
 forever In Test and Upon Condition Neverthelss that the said Deedee R. Edwards is to
 permit the said Nicholas to remain in possession of the said property until the said Charles
 C. Briggs Sampson C. Reese and Ann C. Nicholas or either of them or the Executors or ad-
 ministrators of either of them shall in writing request the said Deedee R. Edwards his Executors or ad-
 ministrators to make sale of the property aforesaid And whereas it is further met that so soon
 as he shall be so requested he the said Deedee R. Edwards (or in case of his death for his personal
 Representatives who is hereby authorized to act) shall set up and sell at public auction the
