Bond and Interest to the said Rich R. Strong Heo Now this Indenture Witnesseth
that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Gentry
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged both parties have paid and sold and by these
presents doth grant bargain and sell to the said John M. Gentry his heirs Executors and assigns
the following property. One Bay mare all my interest in the growing Crop of Cotton (Crops)
that is to say one fifth part of the Corn Cotton Peas and Potatoes also the one fifth of the black
fodder which may be made on the farm of the said John Cooper as that is the proportion
sum to receive by Contract with Cooper for my services on said Cooper's farm to him the said
John M. Gentry his heirs Executors and assigns forever. In Trust nevertheless and upon the
express Condition that if the said Bernice Edwards his heirs heirs or assigns shall need
and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Rich R. Strong Heo the said Bond
Interest & Cost which may hereon accrue on or before the 20th day of October next then
this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue. Then the said
