At and This Indenture witnesseth that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar to him in hand paid by the said Bentley the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargained and sell to the said John M. Bentley his heirs Executors and Assigns the following property. One bay mare all my interest in the growing Crop of Cotton (Cotton) that is to say one fifth part of the Corn Cotton Bars and Ground also the one fifth of cotton field which may be made or the same of the said Joe Cooper as that is the proportion I am to receive by Contract with Cooper for my services on said Coopers farm to him the said John M. Bentley his heirs Executors and Assigns forever. In Trust Presently and unipended upon Condition that if the said Bennett Edwards his heirs Executors and Assigns shall well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Pitt R. Strong Esq. the said Bond Interest & Cost which may hereon accrue on or before the 20th day of October next then this obligation to be void otherwise to remain in full force and virtue. Then the said John M. Bentley his heirs Executors and Assigns at the request of either party Shall adjuice and sell at public Auction the property herein Conveyed to date by the said Pitt R. Strong Esq. and then if any Surplus remain Shall satisfy an Account in the hands of David Savage Constable against me and Pitt R. Strong my Surety with all cost and interest which may have accrued thereon also satisfy a sum created by me with William T. Blow my Surety to Joshua Dicks for five dollars entered and cost of any the balance if any Shall pay over to the said Bennett Edwards or his Order Given this and sworn before me and Seal this 29th day of July 1833.
