Pounds of money Six dollars due the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June One thousand Eight hundred and  
thirty three One other Bond of One hundred and Ninety five dollars and Ninety  
cents due the 25<sup>th</sup> of December next and having demands and willing to have the  
payment thereof have as well for the several sums of money six dollars due the  
day of June One thousand Eight hundred and thirty three and other Bonds of  
One hundred and Ninety five dollars and Ninety Six Cents due the 25<sup>th</sup> of Octo-  
ber ad also One dollar to me in hand paid by Anthony Woodard as trustee  
whereof is hereby acknowledged. I the said John et Thomas have granted  
and sold unto the said Anthony Woodard his heirs and assigns the following  
property limit One tract of land which he the said John et Thomas purchased  
of James Harrison containing by estimation Ninety five acres adjoining the farm of  
Blunt George Fox and William et Jones et worth itself to have the sum of Two thousand
