This Indenture made and entered into the 29 day of July 1833 between ^{Jeremiah Sorner} of the one part, Eliza Scours of the second part and Bernitt Edwards & of the third part the County of Smithampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Jeremiah Sorner is justly indebted to the said Eliza Scours on the sum of Seventy five dollars and some bearing date Equal with these presents and the said Eliza Scours being and desiring to secure the payment of the said Bond to the said Eliza Scours aforesaid Indenture Witnesses that for and in Consideration of the sum of One dollar to be paid by the said Bernitt Edwards the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell to the said Bernitt Edwards his heirs Executors and Administrators the following property to wit One half of my present growing Crop of Corn and Potatoes and my whole Crop of Sweet Potatoes to him the said Bernitt Edwards his heirs Executors and Administrators for ever. In Witness whereof and upon the Conditions that if the said Jeremiah Sorner shall ever and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the said Eliza Scours the aforesaid Bond with interest and costs then the gift to be void otherwise to remain in full force and Virtue. These the said Bernitt Edwards has said or said shall at the request of either party aforesaid and clear the property herein conveyed by giving ten days previous notice at three or more public places within the County aforesaid and after satisfying the said Eliza Scours the surplus if any pay over to the said Eliza Scours or his Order. In Testimony hereof we have this day and year above written signed sealed and acknowledged above obligation

I know all men by these presents that John A Thomas of Smithampton County State of Virginia being indebted to John Sorner of the County aforesaid for the sum of money Six dollars and 17 Cents of Some One thousand Eight hundred and thirty three One other Bond of One hundred and seventy five dollars and twenty five Cents due the 25th of December next and being desirous and willing to secure the payment thereof have as well for the aforesaid sum of ten only Six dollars and twenty five Cents of Some One thousand Eight hundred and thirty three and other Bond of One hundred and seventy five dollars and twenty five Cents due the 25th of December next as also One dollar to me in hand paid by Andrew Woodard as trustee of the said John A Thomas hereby acknowledged. I the said John A Thomas have granted bargain and sold unto the said Andrew Woodard his heirs and assigns the following property to wit One tract of land to which he the said John A Thomas purchased of James Harris or Containing by estimation about four acres adjoining Benjamin's Plant George Sorner and William A Jones at which place to have the aforesaid
