This Indenture made and entered into on the 15 day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty three by and between Benjamin Worrell of the first part Jonathan Griffis of the second part and Jacob Barnes of the third part and last part each respectively the parties herein residents of the County of Southampton in the State of Virginia wherein said Benjamin Worrell stands justly indebted to the said Jacob Barnes in the sum of Three hundred and thirty three dollars and 86 Cents which debt appearing due and owing bearing date with as this Indenture it self the same being payable and demandable payment of which together with the legal interest accruing thereon the said Mr. Worrell are willing and desirous effectually to affre and disend to the said Mr. Barnes and now therefore this Indenture witnesseth that the said Benjamin Worrell as well in consideration of the premises as of the further sum of One dollar and twenty five cents money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Jonathan Griffis and before the ensailing and delivery of these presents the full sum of due and owing aforesaid and from every part of which the said Jonathan Griffis and all his legal representatives are forever released exonerated and discharged hereto he Worrell have as appears herein bargained and sold unto the said Jonathan Griffis his heirs and assigns the following named property to wit Three feather beds and frame one blue painted Chest six Setting Chairs one table painted red one duteous or desk and book to each one fry pan one Spiss cobel pair Birds Case of knives and fork for ploughing one Coaster one dozen ploughs one grub hoe from each of meadow row hedge two Carts and one pair Cest wheels seventeen Hrots one Sot and increase of all Said Hrots two Cens and two Calves and their increase both the present growing Crop consisting in Corn Cotton peas fodder tobacco and One Pound Stere to have and to hold the said property and every part thereof that is all the right title inherit and Estate therein in every way and manner whatsoever the said John Griffis his heirs and assigns forever to the only person now and hereafter the said Jonathan Griffis his heirs and assigns forever In First Mortality if the said Benjamin Worrell his Executer or administrator or any other person firm and at his request at any proportion hereafter that is to say before the sale of above named property shall pay to the said Jacob Barnes his heirs Executors the aforesaid sum of Three hundred and thirty three dollars and 86 Cents together with the legal interest accrued theron and also the Cost of recording and all other Cost and Charges incurred in carrying into effect this Indenture and every thing herein contained is to be void and of none effect but if the said Benjamin Worrell no other person aforesaid shall have or claim not pay the aforesaid sum of said costs and charges as aforesaid or such part thereof as shall appear not to have been paid shall then and in such case the said Jonathan Griffis his Executors shall and may sell so much or all of the foregoing named property for cost of sale and out of the monies raised by such sale pay and satisfy all costs and charges incurred thereby together with the aforesaid debt and interest and if any sum remaining thereafter remains the same shall be paid over by the said Jonathan Griffis his Executors or administrators to him the said Benjamin Worrell who shall be entitled to receive the same and of the aforesaid debt interest and cost to be paid prior to the sale of the property herein named him and in that case
