This Indenture made this 23rd day of February 1833. between James Edwards of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the first part Buckner D. Rankin of the second part and John R. Williams and Henry Jorgens of the third part Witnesseth that whereas the said James Edwards is justly indebted to John R. Williams and Henry Jorgens in the sum of seventy five dollars due by Note and bearing date September 15th next and Henry Jorgens and dismists to demand the payment of the same then this Indenture doth effect that for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar or thereabouts paid by Buckner D. Rankin to the said James Edwards at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said James Edwards hath given granted bargained and sold and delivered and do by these presents give grant bargain and sell unto the said C. D. Rankin his heirs &c One bond Colt One feather bed and furniture one Cart and wheels all his crop of any kind that he make for the present year and next four succeeding years and every other species of property that in any wise belongs to him the said James Edwards To have and to hold the same upon Trust that said C. D. Rankin his heirs &c shall permit the said James Edwards to keep the same in quiet possession until default be made in the payment of the aforesaid sum of Seventy five dollars either in the whole or in part and so soon as default be made in payment of the aforesaid debt the said Buckner D. Rankin shall at the request of him the said John R.
