and Henry Lawrence of the second part and John E Lawrence of the third part both of the  
Isles of Wight and all of the State of Virginia Whereas the said Solomon Crumpler  
doth severally indebted to the said John Lawrence in the sum of five hundred and five dollars  
Bonds bearing date on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1833 with legal interest thereon accruing it  
Solomon Crumpler doth Willing and desire to Sure. As per this Indenture Whereas  
that for and in Consideration of the premises and also for the further Consideration of the  
of lawful Money of Virginia to the said Solomon Crumpler in hand paid by the said  
Lawrence at and before the Sealung and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof  
acknowledged by the said Solomon Crumpler hath given granted bargained sold  
enfeoffed released and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargained sold  
enfeoffed released and confirmed to the said Mills E Lawrence his heirs and assigns  
the following property to wit One tract of land lying in the County of Southampton  
by the most ancient Mates and bounds beginning at a Cypress corner tree of Thomas  
and Solomon Crumpler thence along a straight line of marked trees to a distance of  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles  
Solomon Crumpler thence a straight line of marked trees to find a corner tree of  $\frac{1}{2}$  miles  
and thence along a line of marked trees to Seacock Swamp thence dimidiate  
to the first Station containing by estimation One hundred and twenty five acres hec  
or less also ten negroes named and Simey fifty Pounds of Corn three thousand  
blades foeder twenty five bushels of hay Six bushels of Coal and by some  $\frac{1}{2}$  cwt of  
Singularly appertaining in any way appertaining and all the right  
interest of the said Solomon Crumpler in and to the said granted or intended  
Rerely granted to have and to hold the said property above mentioned having  
unto the said Mills E Lawrence his heirs Exclusively & Exclusively forever his  
proper use and behoef of the said Mills E Lawrence his heirs Executors  
appris. do hereby covenant promise and agree to and with the said Mills E  
Lawrence his heirs Executors and assigns forever on Manners and following that is to say  
the said Solomon Crumpler his heirs Executors and Assigns the aforesaid property  
Mentioned herby carried into the said Mills E Lawrence his heirs Executors  
and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and
