

This Indenture made this 19th day of August 1833. Between William Davis
 his wife of the County of Southampton and Parish of St. Mary of the one part and
 David of the same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said William
 and wife for and in consideration of the Sum of Five hundred and thirty five
 and fifty six pence in hand paid by the said Samuel Davis the receipt whereof the
 William Davis and wife doth acknowledge & consent fully and amply to have
 have granted bargained sold and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sold unto the said Samuel Davis one certain tract or parcel of land and premises con-
 tained and lying and situate in the County aforesaid containing by a late Survey of the
 and Twenty five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows To wit
 a Black Gum Standing in a Swamp called Stottersay Swamp running thence
 Davis line of Munkatow to a small branch thence along the branch to Thomas
 Mill Pond thence down the said Mill Pond the Runway comes to the first
 Mill Pond thence along that back to Stottersay Swamp thence along the branch
 to the first station with all the houses edifices and improvements ways ditches
 water courses what ever in any wise appertaining. To have and to hold the
 land to him the said Samuel Davis to him and his heirs for ever and the William
 and wife for themselves their heirs doth by these presents covenant and grant that
 Davis his heirs and assigns that the said William Davis and wife their heirs
 for ever defend all rights title claims or demands of any part or part thereof
 person claiming or demanding the same. In Testimony whereof the said William
