Governor of the Commonwealth of Virginia in the just and full sum of One thousand dollars to be paid to the said Governor and his Successors for the use of the Commonwealth, for the payment whereof real and true to be made we bind ourselves our heirs Executors and assigns heirs jointly and severally firmly by these presents sealed with our seals and dated this 16th day of September 1833.

The Consideration of the above obligation is such that whereas the Court of Surinhampton County have appointed the above named George E. Gray Commissioner of the Revenue for the Parish of St. Mary in the said County for the term of one year, Now if the said George E. Gray shall faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during the term aforesaid then the above obligation to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue Signed sealed and delivered
