Between James Clayton of the first part, Godwin Johnson of the second part and Willson Stephenson of the third part: Whereas the said Godwin Johnson on the 2^d day of October in the year of our Lord 1831. in Order to secure the payment of the sum of Sixty Eight dollars to the said Willson Stephenson did by Indenture of Trust of that date convey to the said James Clayton his heirs Executors &c. the following property to wit, One half of the land whereon the said Godwin Johnson now resides containing One hundred acres bounded by the land of James Clayton, Joseph Snyper, Lemuel B. Emmett dec'd lands and the main town of Shesapeake strung upon Trust for the uses and purposes in the said Indenture mentioned And whereas since the executing and delivering of the said Deed of Trust the said Godwin Johnson hath fully satisfied and paid to the said Willson Stephenson the several sums of money thereby secured which the said Willson Stephenson doth hereby acknowledge Now this Indenture Witnesseth that for the consideration of One dollar in hand paid by the said Willson to the said James Clayton at and before the executing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Clayton with the consent and approbation of the Willson Stephenson signified by his living party to these
