This Indenture made this 21st day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty two, by and between Dixon Gardner and Mary Gardner, his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Elisha Holland of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Dixon Gardner and his wife for and in consideration of Sum of Twelve dollars to them in hand paid by the said Elisha Holland and to have the censual interest therein of these premises the receipt whereof the said Dixon Gardner and Mary his wife do hereby acknowledge and Elisha Holland is therewith satisfied. Contracted and paid shall be granted bargained sold aliened confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sold alien and confirm unto the said Elisha Holland his heirs and assigns forever, a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton aforesaid containing two acres or thereabouts parcel of land which I bought the land of David Gardner and his wife together with the reversum and reversions remain and remainments unto the said Dixon Gardner. To have and to hold the said bargained premises with all the profits Tenants and advantages of every kind whatsoever to the said tract belonging to the said Elisha Holland and his heirs and assigns forever and they the said Dixon Gardner and Mary his wife for themselves their heirs Executors and Administrators do and they by these presents do warrant and forever defend the said bargained premises with the appurtenances aforesaid against the lawful claims of all and every person or persons whatsoever. unto whom the said Elisha Holland his heirs and assigns forever Testimony whereof they the said Dixon Gardner and Mary his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and year first above written.
