The condition of the above obligation is such that whereas the Court of Southampton County have appointed the above bonds, John M. Gurley, Commissioner of the Revenue of the Parish of Saint Lukes in the said County, Clerk of the said Court shall faithfully perform the duties of the said Office during the term of years to then the above obligation to be void and these remain in full force and effect.

This Indenture made and entered into this sixth day of November one thousand eight hundred and thirty three between Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Robert T. Musgrave of the County and State aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to the said Barrow in hand paid by the said Musgrave the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said Henry Barrow and Rebecca his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell to the said Musgrave his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia and being the tract of land which formerly constituted part of Jno. A. Rogers tract, and by a Judgment of the County Court of Southampton County was awarded by a jury to the said Barrow in the year one thousand seven hundred and and given by the said Jno. Barrow by his last Will and Testament to the said Henry Barrow his grand son: and bounded as follows on the North by the land of S^r T. Island, on the East by the lands of S^r T. Island, and the said Musgrave on the South by the lands belonging to the Estate of Tho^s Mason dec^d and Northington Ellis and on the West by the land of Anst^s Drew. The line running as follows, Begⁿ at Summers road at Sprades branch thence N 30 West 146 poles to a pine, thence N 34 36 poles to a pine on S^r T. Islands line then along Islands line N 70 West 88 poles to a black oak then S 8^o West 65 poles to the redy branch then down S^r branch S 28 West 34 poles to a Yellow oak a corner on what was S^r Islands line thence east 44 poles to a pine S 10^o E 87 poles to a white oak then S 15 West 126 poles to a dead W^o oak stump then S 29^o E 42 poles to a Spanish oak, then S 66 East 10 poles to a pine in the head of Cox^s Swamp then down the S^r Swamp N 10 East 24 poles then S 23 East 12 poles then S 35 E 22 poles N 13 East 18 poles, to the mouth of Sprades branch, thence up the run of S^r Island
