 Bonds of a Writ of Right and in Consideration of the natural love and affection which I have towards
 my Son William R. Corbitt as well as for the further Consideration of the Sum of one dollar
 to me in hand paid by the said William R. Corbitt at or before the making of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have given and granted and by these presents do
 give and grant unto the said William R. Corbitt his heirs and assigns forever one certain
 part or parcel of land and premises containing by a late Survey Sixty three acres 3 Roods
 and 19 poles and bounded as follows Beginning at a gum at the head between John
 Corbitt and said land thence running a straight line of marked trees to a Maple a Corner
 thence a line of marked trees to a post oak a Corner of Richard Corbitt and said land
 thence a line of marked trees by said Richard Corbitt's land to a gum a Corner of said Richard
 Corbitt and said land and thence a line of marked trees to the beginning. together with all
 and singular the Houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens ways, waters and
 water courses and all the profits belonging to the said lands. To have and to hold
 unto the said William R. Corbitt his heirs Executors administrators and assigns forever and the
 said Samuel Corbitt Son for himself his heirs by the said 63 acres 3 Roods and 19 Poles of
 land unto the said William R. Corbitt his heirs and assigns forever against the claim of him
 the said Samuel Corbitt and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever. Shall and

 Wells his heirs and assigns all of my lands which I have from my father James Pond
 and are bounded by the lands of Seth H. Pond Peter Pond Thomas Gray and John
 together with all and singular houses buildings or other lands tenements ways
 water courses enclosures hereditaments and appurtenances what ever to the said lands
 and interest. To have and to hold the aforesaid interest and land with its ten-
 ements hereditaments and all and singular other the premises herein mentioned
