This Indenture made the 16th day of November A.D. 1833, between Hardy Cobb and Marthes Cobb
of the County of Southampton of the one part and James Taylor of the County of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Hardy Cobb and Marthes his wife in consideration of the sum of five
hundred and ten dollars to them or him paid by the said James Taylor at the conveyance
delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold
and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said James Taylor
his heirs and assigns a certain tract of land containing one hundred and sixteen acres and
lying and being in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands of George Williams
on the West, E. H. Gurd on the S. E. Richard E. C. Rutter on the S. E. and the town of
Nicholson's Mill ponds from the old Bridge to George Williams' land together with all
and singular the appurtenances therunto belonging or in any way appertaining
To have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular other of the premises
herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel
thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said James Taylor
his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Hardy Cobb and Marthes his wife for
themselves and their heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the premises
and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said James Taylor his heirs and assigns
free from the claims or claims of them the said Hardy Cobb and Marthes his wife
or either of them their or either of their heirs and of all and every person or persons
whatsoever. Shall well and do warrant and forever defend by these premises. In

their hands and seals the day and year first above written.
