 thirty three between Nicholas Richey and wife of Southampton County and State of North Carolina
 of the one part and Henry Moore of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia
 of the other part. That Nicholas Richey and wife have sold unto Henry Moore
 that eighth tenth and one eighth in one certain tract or parcel of land in the County of South-
 ampton for the sum of One hundred and twenty five dollars sixty six cents lawful money
 of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Henry Moore the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged have bargained granted and sold and by these presents do bargain grant and
 sell unto Henry Moore that right title and interest in the tract of land formerly the land
 of Thomas Moore containing four hundred and four acres to the same more or less and
 bounded by the lands of Christopher Eddis the lands belonging to the heirs of Capt. David
 Masson by the lands of Nathaniel M. Francis and the lands of Samuel B. Woodard
 aforementioned had to the deed from Francis to Moore well more fully appear unto
 the said Nicholas Richey and wife with warrant and power before the right and title
